

# CREATIVE LESSON

## THE GOOD DEED BOX

### Task:

To create and decorate a treasure chest to store as many daily good deeds as possible within it!

### AIM:

Students cut out and make their own treasure chest that will contain an abundance of good deed reminders.

### Materials:

- Card
- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloured pens
- Small pieces of paper
- pen

### Instructions:

1. Students cut out the treasure chest template along the lines and assemble it by following the instructions of which sides to glue together
2. Now it's time to decorate the box. This can be however you like. But make it as creative and unique as you can.
3. Once the box is assembled, it's time to write down as many good deeds as we can think of
4. This can be on multiple small pieces of (coloured) paper
5. Once done, fold them up and place each one in the treasure chest and close the lid
6. Place it in a key area at home and endeavour to open one each day and implement that good deed!
