Isa (Jesus)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Son of Mary (Maryam) - Born of miraculous birth - A very elect and highly esteemed messenger of God. (No Muslim is a Muslim if he does not believe this). - Was sent by Allah as a prophet to preach monotheism to the people of Israel. - Was not crucified or killed on the cross – was in fact raised and it only appeared to the Jews and Romans that he was crucified and killed. - Will return to earth towards the end of time to destroy the Dajjal. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Believed to be the son of God. - Trinitarian Christians believe Jesus as the Son of God, God, and the holy spirit of God at the same time. - Was crucified by the Jews who rejected his message, under the Roman Governor at the time. - Died on the cross to forgive the sins of mankind (and the original sin of Adam(as) in the story of Adam & Eve and the forbidden apple) - After he died, believed to have been raised to heaven as the right hand of God. - Will return to earth for the last judgment. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Perceived as a false Messiah - Rejected as the real Messiah
Musa (Moses)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Considered a Prophet sent by Allah,swt to the Pharaoh and the Israelites as a warning and for guidance. - Brother of Harun (Aaron) & Came from the lineage of Abraham(as). - His Mother hid him from the Pharaoh (story of the river and moses basket) – Brought up by the Pharaoh’s wife. - Revealed to him were the original Torah & 10 commandments for the Israelites. - Apart from Adam(as), Moses was the only prophet to have spoken to Allah,swt directly. 	<p>Musa(as) (Moses) came before Christianity, and before Isa(as) (Jesus) was born and came with the message to the people of Israel.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Consider the Prophet of God - Came to save the people of Israel. - Mother hid him from the Pharaoh’s orders of the killing of newborn Hebrew boys. - Found & brought up by an Egyptian royal family. - Spoke to God through the burning bush - Led the Israelites across the Red Sea - Received the 10 Commandments from God on Mount Sinai - Spent 40 years in the desert with the Israelites in search of the Promised Land.
