PAPER CHAIN OF GOOD DEEDS!

Task:

To create a long paper chain with as many good deeds as possible!

AIM:

Show students the list of good deeds is endless and one leads to another just like the paper chain. Students have to come up with as many daily good deeds as they can!

Materials:

- Paper
- Pens
- Glue or tape

Instructions:

1. Each student is given a rectangular piece of coloured paper measuring approx. 15cm by 8cm
2. Students write a daily good deed on this paper (and repeat for as many good deeds as they can think of).
3. The pieces of paper are then made into a ring/circle and glued or taped on the edge
4. Each circle is intertwined with another to make a large paper chain!

An excellent means of peer work and the paper chain can be reviewed every now and then to remind students of daily good deeds to try and get done.
